Coop Design

Read: Poultry House Construction for ideas

Location: Easy harvesting eggs. Some noise, a little smell, consider heat, shade, weather

Our coop (80"w x 60"D x 42"tall)

Ground floor (soil) has 18" clearance to next floor.

Allows space to get out of sun or rain

- Ramp to second floor has cross rails for traction
- 2nd floor allows access to nest boxes and the roosting bars. Full 18" height clearance
- Nest boxes (15"w x 16" D x 18" tall)

Allows full size hens to stand and turn

Height location is above 1st floor but below roosting bars

No direct light into nest boxes

Rubber mat on base to discourage mites

Access to eggs from north side of building, along gravel path, so harvesting is easy

Doors to nest box are at 50" height so children and adults can harvest and keeps predators out

Latches on nest box doors

Roosting bars

Constructed from 2 x 2s. Rounded edges with ¼ round router bit

Location is the highest standing spot in coop

We have two bars at the same height otherwise there will be a fight for height dominance

Cleaning

All floors and nest boxes are accessed by hinged doors

Poo and alfalfa are swept directly into compost bins and covered with existing compost

Cleaning and spreading of new alfalfa takes 10-15 minutes.....three times a year

FOOD/Water

- Organic Chicken Feed Crumbles, 40-50# bag (1/4 #/chicken/day)
 - ➤ Where: Sam's, AnJan, Pet Delight, Half Moon Bay Feed & Fuel
 - ➤ How: Galvanized Hanging Feeder....McMurry

Scratch

- ➤ Where: Sam's, AnJan, Half Moon Bay Feed & Fuel
- ➤ How: Broadcast by hand into chicken run
- Oyster Shells (5-10# bag)
 - ➤ Where: Sam's, AnJan, Half Moon Bay Feed & Fuel, McMurry
 - ➤ How: Small container nailed to post, with drainage
- **Hay-Alfalfa** (Bale—90#)
 - ➤ Where: Sam's, Half Moon Bay and Feed
 - How: Spread in coop, in nest boxes, and in chicken run

Water

- ➤ Where: Use city water
- ➤ How: (2) Little Giant Auto waters from McMurry or Amazon.com

Description:

Coop is a split level condo. Ground floor is an indoor/outdoor covered patio with views to the compost pile and backyard. A sloped ramp leads to the grand room for entertaining, socializing, and dancing. From the grand room it is a either a hop into one of the two nest boxes, when a hen feels like giving back to the landlord, or it is a jump to one of two roosting bars for a good night sleep. The entire coop is stained to match the main house exterior doors and windows.

Uniqueness:

Coop was designed on a CAD program to fit in a very specific area in our backyard. My youngest son and I built the coop mostly out of 2x2s and plywood. The coop is integrated with a totally enclosed chicken run, to keep the predators out, and links to our enclosed raised bed gardens so they have extra area to roam and fertilize during the fall and winter months. Coop cleaning is literally a ten minute process due to positioning of hinged doors relative to compost bins. In addition, egg collecting can be accomplished without the risk of a shoe-poop encounter since accessing the nest boxes does not require entering the chicken run.
